

AVIVA ROSENFELD AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN PATIENT CARE IN TRANSPLANTATION

Eligibility and Entry Criteria

Any health care provider (including physicians, surgeons, nurses, psychologists, social workers, other allied health professionals) who provides care to patients and families in transplantation can be nominated. Nominations can be submitted by transplant recipients, donors, donor families and colleagues.

- Nominees must be practising in Australia or New Zealand
- Nominees do not have to be a member of TSANZ
- Optional - submit a photo of patient, clinician or both
- The judging panel will include the Award Chairs, a representative of TSANZ council, a representative of Transplant Australia and a patient representative.
