1. How would you describe your research proposal to a person on the street?

Provide a non-technical summary of your research project. Why is it important? What will you do? How will it help people undergoing transplantation?

2. What is your hypothesis?

3. What are you going to do?

Provide some details of your project plan. What methodologies will you use? Convince us that you know what you're doing and if the project is feasible.

4. Who is going to be doing the work?

Tell us about you and your research team. Where are you based? What research experience do you have? Who else is in your project team? Who will you be collaborating with? (bonus points if you're planning to work with multiple sites and/or inter-disciplinary groups)

5. Why should we give you \$10,000?

Convince us that your project is worth funding! Why does it matter? How is it novel? What impact will it have? (bonus points for being creative and thinking outside the box)

6. How will this grant help you build to bigger and better things?

Where are you going next? How will this help you get there? How will this grant help you leverage more funding?

- Have you been a financial member of TSANZ for at least 12 months? Yes/No
- Will this research be conducted primarily in Australia or New Zealand? Yes/No
- Has the project received any prior funding? Yes/No
