The post is open to medically qualified applicants who should hold the **FRACP** or equivalent qualification and be eligible for vocational registration with the New Zealand Medical Council.

Te Toka Tumai's Renal Transplant Unit provides services for 9 other hospitals and performs approximately 130 transplants each year. This includes blood group incompatible kidney transplants and is the national referral centre for combined pancreas and kidney transplantation. We provide nephrology services for the central Auckland Region including haemodialysis for 350 patients which involves an active home haemodialysis service. The peritoneal dialysis unit provides care for approximately 60 patients.
