#### OrganMatch is LIVE

OrganMatch went live as scheduled on 2 April 2019 with the successful implementation of the system in all the Tissue Typing labs across the country and all data migrated from the legacy system, NOMS. OrganMatch now provides the lab-users, with a state of the art platform with the following modules delivered

- Registration, program and waitlist management
- Histocompatibility Testing and patient/donor assessment
- Matching and allocation
- Reporting

OrganMatch will support all existing programs including the deceased organ donor program, living donor kidney transplants, and the Australian Paired Kidney Exchange Program.

The architecture and infrastructure of OrganMatch has the capacity to deliver further functionality through the addition of three key system enhancements:

- OrganMatch Clinical Portal
- Self-service reporting
- OrganMatch Simulation Module

#### **CLINICAL PORTAL**

Delivery of the Clinical Portal will allows clinicians and transplant coordinators to access their recipient's real time data in any location.

Each user will have a unique logon with a two-step authentication process.

The clinical units will have direct access to recipient information

- Enrolment status
- Program and Pathway
- TWL Match History view rank, score , offer status for your patients
- Immunological data HLA typing, Unacceptable and acceptable antigen assignment
- Clinical reports issued by the Tissue Typing laboratories
